Special Event Volunteer Opportunities

- Academic Fair & Egg Drop:**
Volunteer during the school day, or at the evening Fair event (held mid-October)
- Fun Run:**
Set up help and support for the Fun Run during school hours (event occurs in October)
- Trivia Night:**
Help plan, set up, or clean up this event (November evening)
- Cookie Crumble & Craft Fair:**
Set up, monitor, or clean up (held on a Saturday in December)
- Fun Fair:**
Set up and help with games, activities, entertainment, and food (Held in February)
- Silent Auction:**
Ask for donations from local businesses and individuals to include in an annual online auction
- Art Fair and Poetry Slam:**
Work with Irving's Teachers to set up for the art, poetry, and music event in May
- Olympic Day:**
Supervise students during a day of sports, games, and other events
- Irving Sleepover:**
Organize activities, serve or donate food, or chaperone
- Book Fair:**
Volunteer your time to sell books, feed the teachers for previews, or help set up or tear down (two book fairs a year, one in the spring, one in the fall)

- Room Parent Coordinator:**
Lead contact and help for all the room parents
- Tuesday Packets & Bulletin Boards:**
Sort and assemble weekly information packets, and hang fliers in the school bulletin boards
- Eagle Extras:**
Help schedule and administer Irving's PTO-sponsored after school classes
- Indoor Recess:**
On site supervision during recess when it's too cold to go outside
- Irving Appreciation Committee:**
Organize or volunteer for teacher lunches, new family dinners, and other events
- WORM Club:**
"Working On Reading in the Morning" Read with students in K-2 from 7:30-8:15 am M-Th
- Library Helpers:**
Shelve and organize books in the Irving Media Center
- Artsonia/Digital Art:**
Work with Irving's Art Teachers to take digital photos of student artwork to share with families
- Box Tops For Education:**
Publicize the program, cut, and count Box Tops
- Cultural Enrichment:**
Research and arrange Cultural Arts programs and presentations for students
